Study Questions:

What is the significance of Palm Sunday? What does it symbolize as the first day in “Passion Week”?

Read Genesis 3:14-19. What stands out to you in these verses? How do you see these “curses” played out in our world?

Read Romans 8:18-25. In what ways does all of creation ‘groan’ and wait for the redemption found in Jesus?

In Zechariah, we see the prophet speaking about the coming Messiah, ‘Behold your king is coming to you...’ Why was Jesus rejected just a few days after Palm Sunday by the Jews?

What prophecies can you name that Jesus fulfilled in His life?

Read Psalm 22. Name all of the instances where there is a direct parallel to Jesus and His last week on this earth before His resurrection.

The most important message of Palm Sunday was that the King had come to Jerusalem. Now we await His Second Coming in which He will complete His Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. What do you most look forward to in His coming?
